

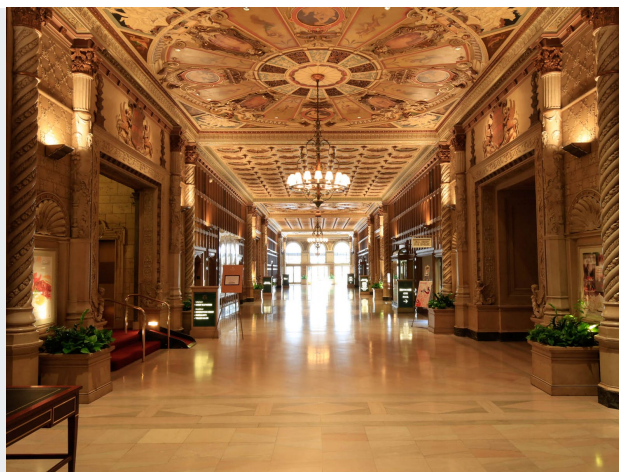

Read on for a three-day itinerary that takes you from the distant past to the hottest new restaurants and bars in LA.

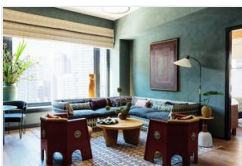

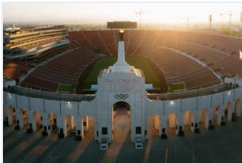
