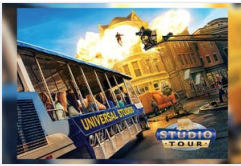


## Mid-Day Magic

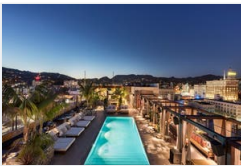

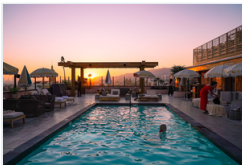


### **Electric Hollywood Nights**
