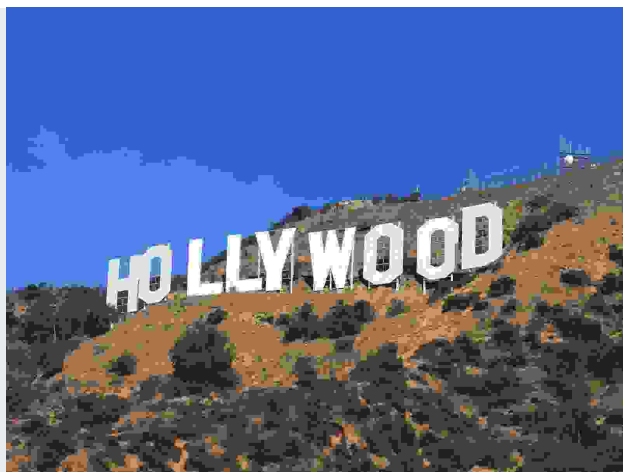

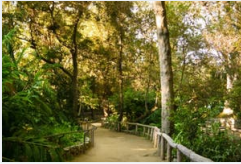

Part 2

Griffith Park

One of the largest municipal parks in North America, **Griffith Park** features 70 miles of trails and some of LA's most famous attractions, including the Hollywood Sign, Griffith Observatory, LA Zoo, The Autry, and Greek Theatre. Explore Griffith Park with free visits to LA icons, along with must-see hidden gems like "the Batcave," Amir's Garden, and the Wisdom Tree.

Part 3

Los Feliz

Located just south of Griffith Park, **Los Feliz** is known for Frank Lloyd Wright's Hollyhock House and Ennis House; the 1923 Vista Theatre, and beloved watering holes Tiki-Ti and Big Bar. Go for a bike ride along the LA River, climb hidden stairs, see a Film Noir location, or browse an incomparable book collection.

Part 4

Silver Lake

Built around its namesake reservoir, **Silver Lake** is a trendsetting neighborhood that's well-known for its modern eateries, boutiques, and nightlife. A historic haven for the LGBTQ community, the Mattachine Steps (named for the Mattachine Society) and The Black Cat (site of a landmark gay rights protest) have been recognized by the City of Los Angeles for their importance in the global LGBTQ movement.
