

Subway to the Sea

With the opening of the Metro Expo Line extension, visitors can travel from Santa Monica to Downtown LA in just 45 minutes. The Expo Line is part of the greater Metro Rail system, connectiong Santa Monica to Downtown LA, Hollywood, Pasadena, Long Beach, and dozens of points in between. The 6.6mile extension adds seven metro stations, offering convenient access to numerous hotels, museums, restaurants and shopping destinations.






