WHAT'S NEW IN LOS ANGELES HOTELS

Trends: Just as the region offers a diverse choice of experiences ranging from coastal calm to urban chic, Los Angeles features plenty of new and reimagined hotels for travelers looking for a getaway. Below is a list of recently opened lodging options and hotels coming soon.

NEW HOTELS

The Winfield Downtown Los Angeles

October 2023

The San Francisco hospitality brand, Sonder, Inc., has launched a new outpost called [The Winfield](#), located within the 1920s [Foreman & Clark Building](#) at 7th and Hill Streets. The 13-story building, formerly a department store and office tower, was converted into a 125-key hotel by [Bonnis Properties](#). The Winfield, named for Foreman & Clark founder Winfield Foreman, features a kitchenette in all guest rooms, which include two penthouse suites that are 2,000 and 2,800 square feet. Other features include a gym, a yoga room, and a terrace deck on the fifth floor. Curlett & Beelman designed the Art Deco and Gothic-style building, which once housed the flagship store and corporate headquarters of the now-defunct Foreman & Clark chain.

Designed to be a charming hideaway in the heart of Hollywood, Palihotel Hollywood will include 74 rooms and suites, a guest-exclusive café and bar, and a courtyard pool at its prime Sunset Boulevard location. Interiors will reflect Palisociety's signature designs, with inspirations from vintage Los Angeles. The property will also feature the inviting Benny's on the Blvd. serving a delicious daytime menu, poolside snacks, and playful cocktails.

Dual-Branded Moxy Downtown Los Angeles and AC Hotel Downtown Los Angeles

April 2023

With a multitude of experiences under one roof, Moxy Downtown Los Angeles and AC Hotel Downtown Los Angeles are DTLA's newest destinations for visitors and locals. Located in the heart of Downtown, directly across from the Los Angeles Convention Center and Crypto.com Arena, the two hotels offer a total of 727 guestrooms and an unprecedented 13 dining and entertainment options, including Level 8, a collection of restaurants, bars and lounges that highlight the neighborhood's diverse cultures and cuisines. The property will also feature a Miami-meets-Copacabana pool deck and over 13,000 square feet of flexible meeting and social events space with a design inspired by DTLA's industrial heritage.

The Delphi Los Angeles (Downtown LA)

April 2023

In Ancient Greece, Delphi was considered the center of the world. A few thousand years later, that essence now resides at 550 Flower Street: a staple of Downtown Los Angeles' silhouette. Once the headquarters of Superior Oil, and then, the focal point of the city's early 2000's revitalization, the address is once again home to creativity, culture, and hospitality. Their 207 rooms and two penthouses err on the side of understated yet teem with high-touch amenities and design elements. Denae's Diner has recently opened on the ground floor, offering all-day dining in a modern-day interpretation of the classic diner.

Hotel Per La (Downtown LA)
2022

[Hotel Per La](https://www.hotelperla.com/) has opened at the former site of the NoMad Hotel in Downtown LA. The 241-room hotel features the Italian restaurant Per L'Ora and Mediterranean restaurant Bar Clara among its food and beverage offerings. Built in 1922 and previously serving as the Bank of Italy headquarters, the building also has a rooftop pool deck, while the hotel includes a 4,000-piece art collection.

The Aster LA (Hollywood)
2022

[The Aster's](https://www.theasterla.com/) spacious 95,000 square ft. private members' club is home to 35 residential-style suites. Hotel guests at The Aster uniquely receive access to the club's member amenities for the length of their stay—including the Sound Studio, Cinema, Salon, Pool, Gym & Wellness Suite, Work Studios & Conference Rooms, three restaurants, five bars, and a brimming calendar of cultural programming.

Conrad Los Angeles (Downtown LA)
2022

Hilton's Conrad luxury brand made its California debut with the opening of the Conrad Los Angeles in July 2022. The 305-room hotel is part of The Grand LA mixed use project, which was designed by architect Frank Gehry and is across the street from Walt Disney Concert Hall. The hotel features a 16,000-square-foot rooftop terrace and pool deck; and 12,000 square feet of meeting space. The Grand LA will also include 176,000 square feet of retail and restaurant space, and 400 private residences.

COMING SOON

The Craftsman (Downtown LA)
Early 2024

A 110-key hotel in Downtown Los Angeles, is expected to open early this year. Originally known as the Lane Mortgage Building, the 12-story, 1923 property was designed by Los Angeles architect Loy Lester Smith, and sits directly opposite the historic Apple Tower Theater. The lobby features original tile artwork by artisan Ernest Batchelder (1875-1957), who inspired the name The Craftsman. Guest spaces are light and airy, with high ceilings and tall windows, while white oak finishes and brass accents create a warm and inviting atmosphere. Units range in size from queen to two-bedroom, accommodating up to 6 guests.

The Whisky Hotel (Hollywood)
2024

Restaurateur Adolfo Suaya (Gaucho Grill) is redeveloping a site near Hollywood's Cahuenga Corridor as a 134-room whiskey-themed hotel. The Whisky Hotel will include whiskey sommeliers and whiskey-filled minibars when it opens later this year.

Mama Shelter Downtown Los Angeles

2026

It was recently announced that the second Mama Shelter location in Los Angeles will transform the existing Mart South Building in the Downtown Fashion District. The property will boast 145 standard rooms and four suites, as well as three festive food and beverage offerings with an all-day dining concept, a café on the ground floor, and a rooftop bar and terrace overlooking the city. The new concept is expected to open in early 2026.
